

17. Academic Sessions

The undergraduate program is of four years duration. Each year is divided into two semesters. Every student needs to clear every semester. The final degree is declared on the basis of average performance of all the eight semesters.

Examination Scheme: Syllabus and examination is as per Mumbai University.

18. Counseling / Mentoring:

Each faculty member is assigned a group of students to take care of their educational and emotional needs. The faculty members keep a track of students' attendance and Performance level in examinations and offers counseling whenever necessary. Telephone numbers of these faculty members are made available to the parents.

Career Counseling:

Training and Placement Cell is the interface between industry and the institute. Ten days of intensive training is organized to third year students to impart professional ethics and etiquettes. The training comprises of soft skills like communication skills and interview techniques.

Medical facilities:

All students in the Institute are covered under a group insurance scheme advised by University of Mumbai which a sum assured of Rs Four Lakh.

The Institute has first- aid center. Additionally the institute has made arrangement with the doctor available in the vicinity to offer immediate medical assistance. For more serious medical attention, there is no. of well appointed hospitals with a 5 min. driving distance from the college. Institute vehicle is provided to shift any student to hospital.
